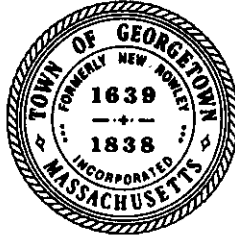

As part of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) stormwater program, operators of regulated small municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s), such as the Town of Georgetown, are required to conduct education and outreach to help reduce pollution in stormwater. To meet this goal, we need the help of all who work, live, and recreate in the town to improve their everyday practices to ensure that the runoff that leaves our parking lots, lawns, and other impervious surfaces is not carrying pollutants that have the potential to impair Georgetown's wetlands and waterways.
